

HYB Development Bursary Entry Form



The Sue Cope HYB Bursary was launched by The Society at the All Breeds All Britain Calf Show in memory of Group CEO Sue Cope. Having successfully competed in YMA herself for a number of years, and a previous winner of the President's Medal Award, Sue was a great supporter of the next generation and one of her earliest roles in the company was as National YMA Coordinator.

The bursary is intended to support Holstein Young Breeders with an interest in completing a course to further their skillset within the dairy industry, or to support those who have an interest in gaining a wider knowledge of international farming practices. The bursary is open to all Holstein Young Breeders aged between 18 and 26 on the 1st January of the corresponding year and they must be a current resident within the UK.

The Bursary

One bursary of up to £1,500 will be awarded on an annual basis and the Holstein Young Breeder is only eligible to apply once per year and must state how they would spend the money in their application (e.g. conference place, international study trip, transport costs, additional certificates, i.e. foot trimming course). Holstein UK will either purchase the equipment or pay monies for these items to the Holstein Young Breeder as appropriate.

Entry Requirements

To apply for the bursary, applicants must submit an entry outlining 'Why I want to be part of the British dairy industry'. Entries can be submitted as either a 500 word written essay, or a two minute video. Entries must be sent to naomilewis@holstein-uk.org, along with the accompanying entry form, by Friday 26th April 2023 and the successful candidate will be chosen by the Board of Trustees.
